## **Troop 124 & 5124 Electronics Policy**

To help scouts be actively present at meetings and outings, and to be considerate of other scouts' experience and the larger natural environment, our troop Electronics Policy is as follows:

- 1. The troop encourages leaving all electronics at home so every scout can be fully engaged in the scouting activity and enjoy the great outdoors.
- 2. The only electronics permitted on outings are a camera or smartphone.
- 3. Electronic devices are only permitted at meetings for the purpose of teaching/participating in classes or assisting with scout advancement with leader approval.
- 4. Smartphones should be out-of-sight and/or out-of-sound to be considerate of other scouters and the environment. Smartphones should be either turned off or on Silent.
- 5. Smartphones and headphones/earbuds are only permitted for the following:
  - Taking photos (following youth protection guidelines).
  - As a scout learning tool (tying knots app, reviewing rank requirements, trail maps, etc), with leader approval.
  - In vehicles during transport to/from outings, with permission of the driver.
  - During free time (with headphones/earbuds).
  - To call a parent/guardian within one hour before returning from an outing to arrange pick-up transportation.
  - For a work-related purpose.
- 6. Recorded music that can be heard by multiple scouts (using any type of speaker) is only allowed with specific SPL <u>and</u> Scoutmaster approval.
- 7. While on an outing, a scout will not call or text home unless the scout has asked and received Scoutmaster approval AND the Scoutmaster participates in the phone call. (This is because if a scout feels sick, homesick, sad, cold, etc troop leaders are on site and are better able to immediately help address the scout's challenge.)
- 8. If a scout chooses not to follow the troop electronics policy their device may be confiscated by an Adult Leader for the duration of the activity.
